

LOCKPORT YOUNG ADULT COURT

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

As a parent or guardian of a participant in the Lockport Young Adult Court (LYAC), I understand that I understand that I also am taking on certain responsibilities. I have read the LYAC Handbook, and I promise to work with the Court in enforcing the rules and regulations. Below is a list of certain responsibilities I understand and agree to abide by:

-In the residence where the participant lives, there can be no alcohol or illegal drugs whatsoever. The participant will be held responsible for any substances found at the residence.

-Home visits will be conducted by the Court and LYAC team at any time day or night. Searches of the residence may also be conducted.

-Family Counseling will be a requirement of graduation from the LYAC. A responsible member of the family will be available to attend the required sessions with the participant.

-As a parent or guardian, I will assist the participant in making all necessary appointments for Court and treatment.

-In reading the Handbook, I understand that certain telephone services may not be utilized by the household (such as blocking out incoming unlisted phone calls). Calling from an unlisted number is a tool used by the Court to verify adherence to curfews.

-All members of the household are aware of the rules and requirements, and agree to assist the participant in their successful completion.

-As parent or guardian, I will notify the Court immediately if I am aware of any violation of the rules (i.e., curfew violation, use of prohibited substances, etc.). I will contact the LYAC Coordinator, Joseph Claypoole, at 439-6673.

I agree to all requirements outlined above, as well as those listed in the Handbook, and I have kept a copy of this for my records.
