## Risk and Needs Tools for DWI



**Q**.

Can you provide us with information we can use to train our team on risk/ needs assessment tools for DUI/DWI?

A.

There are three criminogenic risk/needs tools that have been normed for the impaired driver. The difference between a screening tool and an assessment tool is the time it takes to administer the tool. We list the three tools below, with information on how to get started with them.

**DUI-RANT:** Screening tool that takes approximately 15 minutes to administer

DUI-RANT was derived from the empirically based risk and needs triage tool and is used to improve how offenders are assessed and managed. It generates criminogenic risk and treatment need profiles for DUI offenders to help determine optimal levels of treatment and supervision for each individual. ## Impaired Driving Assessment (IDA):

Assessment tool that can take up to 45 to 60 minutes to administer

Computerized Assessment and Referral System (CARS): Assessment tool that primarily looks at mental health need and criminogenic risk second. It can take 30 to 60 minutes to administer.
