If I violate any of the terms and conditions of the Program, I understand that the court may impose immediate sanctions against me, including jail. Moreover, I understand that continuous violations by me of the terms and conditions of the Program will result in my termination from the Program. If termination occurs, the court will shortly thereafter impose sentence against me on the D.W.I. conviction for which my guilt has already been established. Such a sentence could include mandatory time in jail and / or fines and community service.
I understand that any sanctions imposed as a consequence of my actions <b>DO NOT</b> fall under the following rights guaranteed under the United States and New Mexico Constitutions:
The right to trial hearing by jury, if any; The right to the assistance of an attorney at any hearing, and to an appointed attorney, to be furnished free of charge, if the defendant cannot afford one; The right to confront the witnesses against me and to cross-examine witnesses them as to the truthfulness of their testimony. The right to present evidence on my own behalf and to have the state compel the attendance of witnesses to testify on my behalf. The right to remain silent, to be presumed innocent, and to be proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

I have been advised by an attorney and hereby knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily agree to waive any assertion of the above constitutional rights in exchange for the privilege to participate in the DWI "Sobriety" Drug Court Program.
